

## Maths with Nature



### The Task

Use leaves, sticks and stones to represent numbers and make equations out of nature!

A Leaf = 1

A Stick = 3

A Stone = 5

### Examples

What is the value of 2 Leaves, 1 Stone and 3 Sticks?

Create a sum, from the items you have, where the answer is: 20

Draw +, - or x signs with chalk on the pavement and ask your child to create their own sums for you to do, let them be the teacher!

### You could also try...

- Count the number of legs on a picnic table and ask your child how many legs they would have if they had 5 or 6 picnic tables?
- Create a square out of sticks on the floor and ask your child to count how many different colours or items they can see within the square
